



**Ronald I. Cohen** is author of the 2200-page, 3-volume *Bibliography of the Writings of Sir Winston Churchill* (London and New York 2006) and recipient of the Farrow Award for excellence in the field of Churchill Studies from The Churchill Centre. He regularly answers queries from around the world on Churchillian bibliographical issues, and contributes articles or comments to the “Cohen Corner” in *Finest Hour*, and *The Churchillian*, published by the Churchill Museum in Fulton, Missouri. He frequently speaks in

Canada, the United States and Britain about different aspects of Churchill’s life and literary achievements.

The Cohen Bibliography has been referred to as “magnificent,” “remarkable,” “meticulous,” “exhaustive,” and, as Ron’s wife, Wendy, attests, “the fruit of at least a quarter century of *obsessive* research.” Lady Soames called it an “important - magisterial - work on my father’s writings” and “a massive monument to Winston Churchill’s industry and genius.” Sir Martin Gilbert said that it “is in every way the Mount Everest of the subject.”

Ron Cohen’s interest in Churchill began when he was working for *The Economist* in London in 1964. He attended Churchill’s state funeral. Churchill’s writings hooked him and, after returning to Canada, Cohen began researching his subject in over 100 public and private libraries in North America, Europe, Australia, Africa, Asia and the Middle East.

A Montreal native, and a graduate of Harvard and McGill Universities, Ron has been a practicing lawyer, a law professor at McGill University, Senior Counsel to the televised Quebec Inquiry into Organized Crime, a motion pictures producer, founder and Chairman of the Academy of Canadian Cinema and Television, and National Chair of the Canadian Broadcast Standards Council. He is a member of the Quebec Bar Association, a Senior Fellow of the Faculty of Public Affairs at Carleton University, and the founding President of the Sir Winston Churchill Society of Ottawa. He and his wife, Wendy, live in Ottawa.
