The evening will begin with a "Social Hour" where cocktails will be available from the cash bar. We will spend this hour meeting and greeting invited guests and fellow Churchillians from the Greater Houston area and beyond.

At the conclusion of the social hour, there will be a Champagne Toast to commemorate the heroic memory of Sir Winston S. Churchill. Dinner will immediately follow with Pappadeaux's famous Baton Rouge menu consisting of the Pappadeaux Salad, followed by your choice of entrees consisting of Shrimp Brochette with dirty rice, a Seafood Platter with fried shrimp, catfish, oysters, stuffed shrimp and stuffed crab with French fries, or finally Mahi Quepos which is blackened mahi fillet topped with jumbo lump crabmeat, shrimp and fresh basil finished with a citrus herb sauce with dirty rice. will follow with your choice of Crème Brulee with fresh fruit or Key Lime Pie in a graham cracker pecan crust. All menu selections include French bread, Dessert and Iced Tea, Soda or Coffee.

The Speaker for the evening will be Dr. Warren F. Kimball, the Robert Treat Professor Emeritus at Rutgers University. A long-time Churchill scholar, Dr. Kimball is the editor of *Churchill & Roosevelt: The Complete Correspondence* (3 vols.; Princeton: Princeton Univ. Press, 1984), and author of, *inter alia*, *Forged in War: Roosevelt, Churchill and the Second World War* (New York: William Morrow; London: Harper-Collins, 1997; paperback 1998; Chicago: Ivan Dee, 2003). Dr. Kimball will provide his perspective on the special relationship which existed between our two nations in general, and between Sir. Winston and FDR in particular, among other things. You will not want to miss this special event.
